Materials Needed

- 1) Cotton Fabric
- 2) Elastic Bands
- 3) Fabric Scissors
- 4) Sewing Machine
- 5) Thread (White preferably)
- 6) Flat Surface
- 7) Iron
- 8) Headpins



STEP 1 - Cut out Fabric Pieces

For each mask, you will need two pieces of cotton fabric. Multiply the number of masks you were assigned to make by 2. That's how many fabric pieces you will need to cut out.

- Fabric must be cut in rectangles
- 9 x 6" (9 inches by 6 inches)
 - Length (9 inches)
 - Width (6 inches)



STEP 2 - Cut Elastic Bands

For each mask, you will need two elastic bands. Multiply the number of masks you were assigned to make by 2. That's how many bands you will need to cut out.

- Length of each band: 5.5 inches
- * Please take exact measurement.

TIP! - Cut out all elastic pieces before you start sewing masks.

Important Notes*

- In this video, fabric is initially folded instead of cutting out 2 different pieces. Please cut out 2 pieces of fabric for each mask. It will save fabric;)
- Use this video for reference to see how to attach elastic bands and complete initial sewing before pleats.
- When stitching two fabrics together, place design side facing each other (nice side should be inside the sandwich)

Important Notes*

- You must use an iron to secure the pleats in place! TIP: Before sewing all sides to secure pleats, use an iron to keep in place for easier stitching!
- After making one mask, feel free to try it on and make sure that bands are not too loose and mask is comfortable to wear
- Don't worry about the clips being used in video, they are optional. If you would like to use something to keep fabric in place, you can use the headpins that were provided to you or whatever you like that is at your house (binder/paper clip).

Important Notes;)

- Always make sure to back stitch when sewing on elastic bands!
- Once pleating is complete, make sure to stitch all four corners, and THEN you are done!
